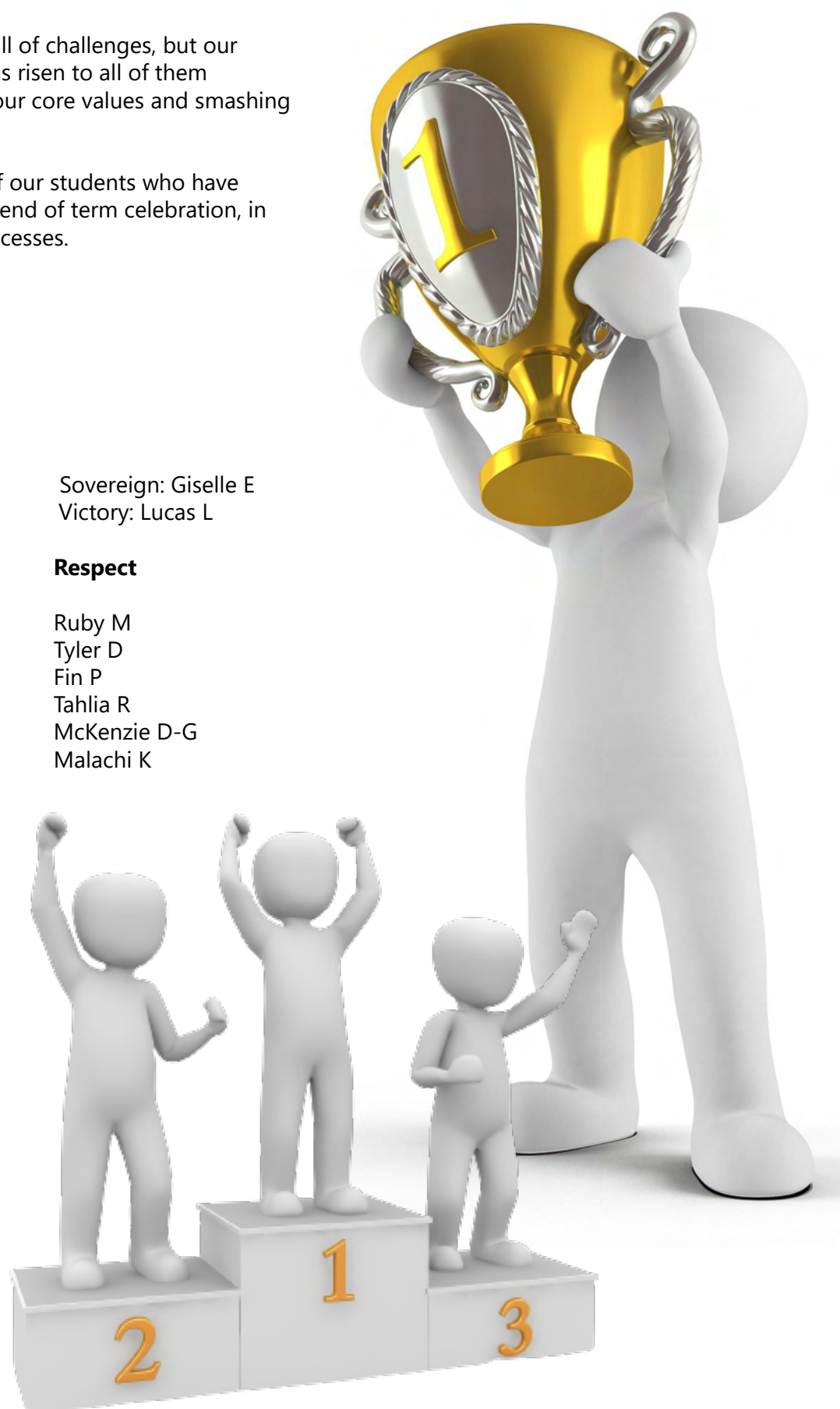

## January Covid-19 Testing Schedule

As you may be aware, the Department for Education has announced that all students will need to complete one COVID-19 test on the school site as part of their return to school process in January. Therefore, we will be testing on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Years 10 and 11 will then begin school on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022, with all other year groups back in school on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2022. This will help ensure the safety of our school community and lead to a positive start to term.

### Consent and Registration

The consent forms that were completed by parents previously are still applicable for this round of on-site testing however, if you would like to discuss this further or withdraw consent then please inform the school.

The registration process remains the same as last time; all students must register online before their test using their registration card (enclosed) and the test site ID which is TC1Q. You can register up to 24 hours before the test but no sooner. Students must then bring their registration cards with them on the day they test.

### Testing Overview

1. Register for your test online using the Registration Card (up to 24 hours before your test)
2. Ensure you have the Registration Card with you on day of test
3. Enter school site at your scheduled time through the Main Entrance (car park)
4. Listen to staff guidance showing you how to complete the swabbing process
5. Exit the site immediately after you have tested

Please note that school uniform does not need to be worn during the testing process.

### Virtual Learning

Class work will be uploaded onto Google Classroom for students to work through from home, following their normal timetable. However, students will not need to complete work during their scheduled testing slot. As Year 7 testing is split across two days, they will be given 60 minutes of Lexia work to complete during the morning they do not test.





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
