Facebook Messenger is a free encrypted, instant mobile messaging app owned by Facebook.

The App lets users add short videos, voice messages and GIFs to instant messages.

Users can send messages to individual people or in group chats, with similar features to WhatsApp.

Adjust your privacy settings on your Facebook account:

- On your chat screen tap on your profile photo in the top left
- Scroll down and select Privacy.
- From here you can configure Message Delivery and Secret Conversations.




Block a user using these simple instructions:

- Scroll down and tap **Block**.
- Here you can block on Messenger and on Facebook.



Report a user using these simple instructions:

- At the top of your conversation, tap on the user's profile picture that you want to block.
- Scroll down and tap Something's Wrong.
- Let Messenger know why you want to report them.
- Tap on **Send Feedback**.
