Bronze Award Expedition




In May our Bronze DofE students completed their expedition and absolutely smashed it!

Activities Week 2023 took things to new heights!


Building on the success of 2022, students have enjoyed a range of activities during the week, getting a chance to experience things outside of the normal curriculum.




In school there were plenty of activities, including the ever popular Trafalgar Bake Off and Multi Sports Days.

Students were able to go to Goals, enjoy retro gaming or test their skills on the Ninja Warrior assault course.










COLLEGE TAST
