Covid rules have been updated again and are now as follows for children and young people:

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and are well enough to attend. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice states they will only need to isolate for 3 days. From Friday 1 April: regular asymptomatic testing is no longer recommended in any education or childcare setting, including in SEND, alternative provision and children's social care settings.

Performing Arts Department Update

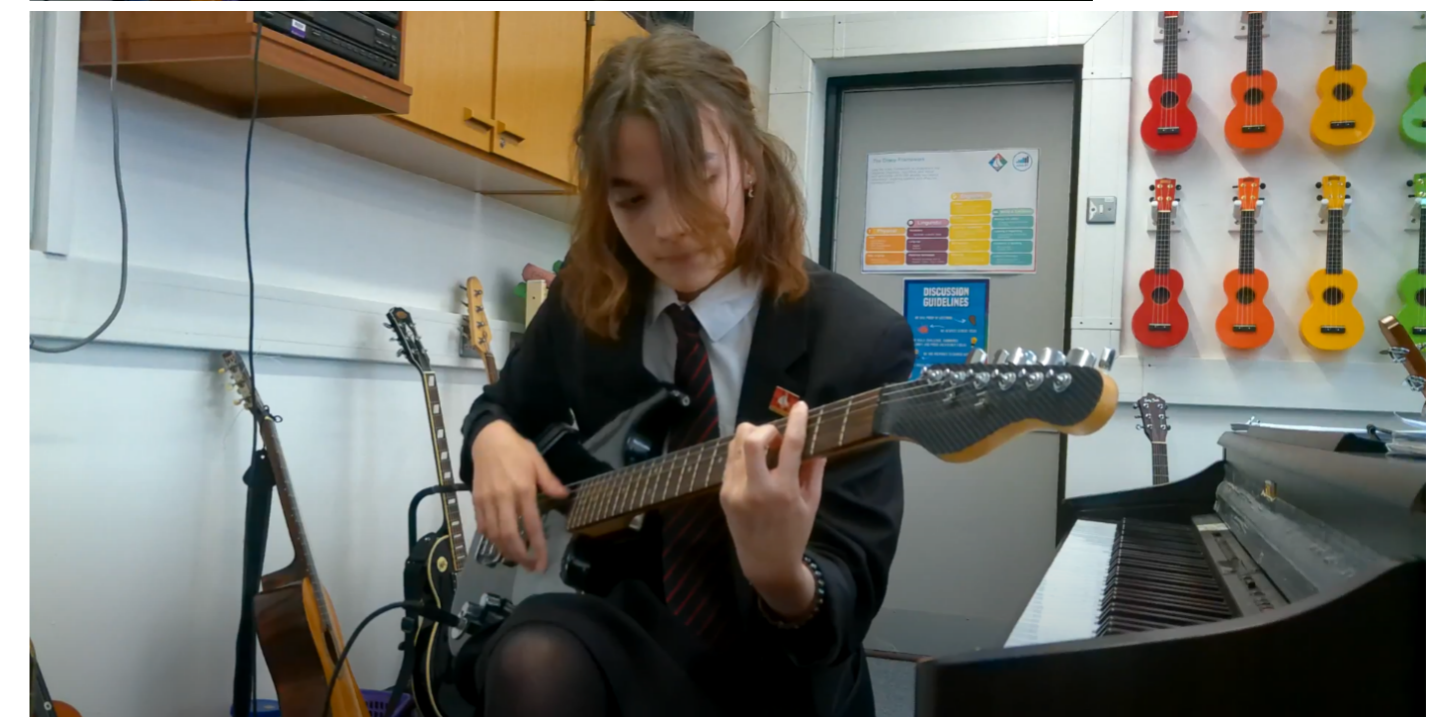
Music

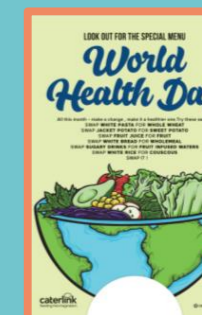


IN SEASON : CARROT
