Mobile Phones in School

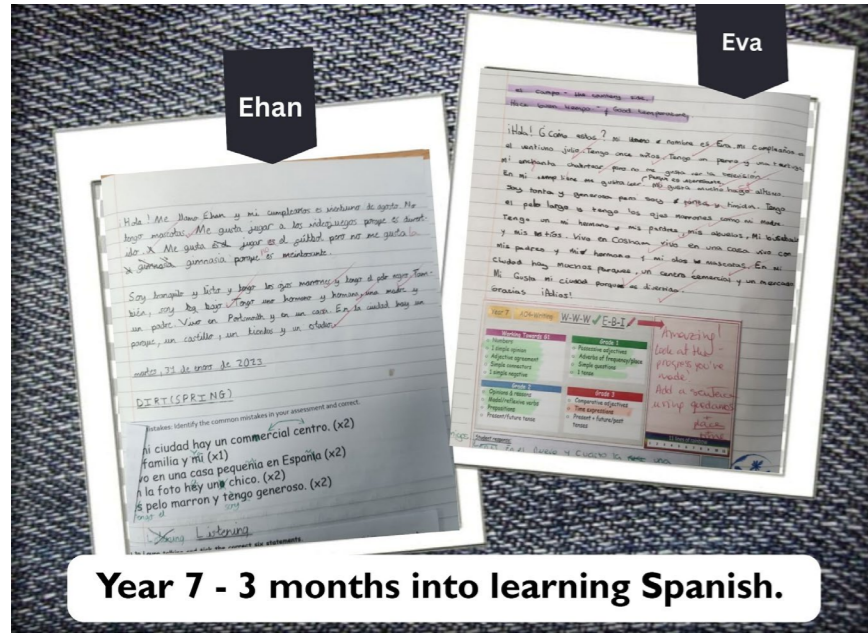

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MFL Department Update

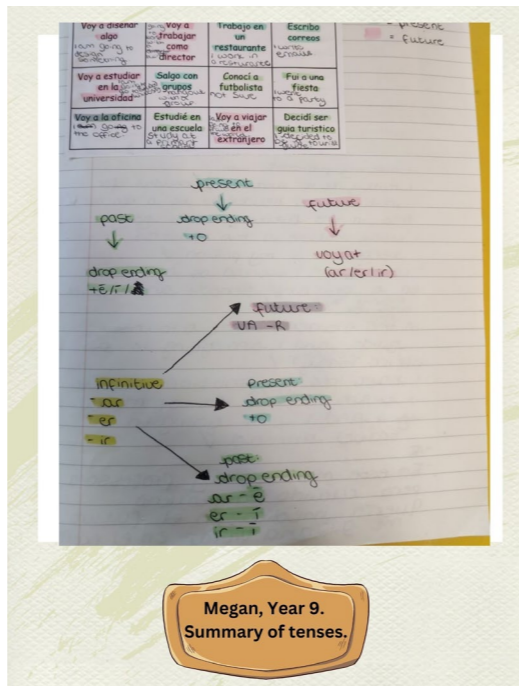


Year 7 - 3 months into learning Spanish.
